 - i. To conduct general search of any premise as it considers necessary
 - j. To ensure the safety of infrastructure and public buildings

BASIC COURSE RECRUITMENT CONDITIONS

- 5. Any person to be admitted in Rwanda National Police must meet the following conditions:
 - (1) To be Rwandan Nationality
 - (2) To voluntary apply
 - (3) To be at least 18 years old and not more than (25) years old
 - (4) To hold a senior six (6) certificate or another certificate certifying that he/she has capacities corresponding to the recruitment level
 - (5) To have good conduct and morals
 - (6) Not to have had any criminal conviction of more than six months
 - (7) To be healthy and strong enough to work in Police, this being supported by a medical certificate issued by a Doctor registered by the State
 - (8) Not to have been dismissed from his functions without consultation or expelled from any public service without notice
 - (9) To have passed tests for recruitment into the Rwanda National Police
